

OCTOBER MILK PRODUCTION DOWN 0.2 PERCENT

Milk production in the 20 major States during October totaled 12.0 billion pounds, down 0.2 percent from October 2002. September revised production, at 11.6 billion pounds, was down 5 million pounds from September 2002. The September revision represented an increase of 2 million pounds from last month's preliminary production estimate.

Production per cow in the 20 major States averaged 1,550 pounds for October, 11 pounds above October 2002.

The number of milk cows on farms in the 20 major States was 7.72 million head, 70,000 head less than October 2002, and 25,000 head less than September 2003.

The Mideast Marketing Area has four states represented in the 20 major states used above. They are Indiana, Michigan, Ohio, and Pennsylvania. Milk production in these Mideast states during October totaled 1.9 billion pounds, down 56 million pounds or 29 percent from October 2002.

Production per cow in the Mideast states averaged 1,514 pounds for October, 16 pounds above October 2002.

The number of cows on farms in the Mideast states was 1.3m illion head, 38,000 head less than October 2002.

ORDER 33 MARKET SUMMARY

The Producer Price Differential for the Mideast Marketing Area for November 2003 was \$046 and the Statistical Uniform Price was \$13.93 for the month. The Statistical Uniform Price is \$0.32 lower than last month, and is \$2.76 higher than November 2002.

The Producer Butterfat Price of \$1.2877 per pound increased 3.24 cents from Ocober 2003 and is up 1954 cents from a year ago. The Protein Price of \$2.9267 is down 3548 cents from last month and is up \$1.0798 from November 2002. The Other Solids Price in November was \$0.0368 per pound, an increase from last month's price of \$00311 and a decrease of 4.82 cents from last November. The Somatic Cell Adjustment rate for November was \$0.00075. November producer receipts of 144 billion pounds were 33.1 percent higher than October 2003, and 8.8 percent higher than November 2002 production of 132 billion pounds. Producer milk allocated to Class I accounted for 37.5 percent of the total producer milk in November 2003, less than the 54.2 percent in October and less than the 43.0 percent in November 2002. A total of 10,543 producers were pooled on the Mideast Order with an average daily delivery of 4545 pounds compared to 10,907 producers pooled in November 2002 with an average daily delivery of 4036 pounds.

The market average content of producer milk w as as follows: Butterfat 3.78 %; Protein 3.10 %; Other Solids 5.69 % and Nonfat Solids 8.79 %.
